

# MEMORY VERSES


## Monday — Hebrews 11:7

By faith **NOAH**, being warned of **GOD** of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an **ARK** to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became **HEIR** of the righteousness which is by faith.



## Tuesday — Genesis 6:18

But with thee will I establish my **COVENANT**; and thou shalt come into the **ARK**, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.



## Wednesday — Genesis 7:1-2

And the **LORD** said unto **NOAH**, Come thou and all thy house into the **ARK**; for thee have I seen righteous before **ME** in this generation. Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by **SEVENS**, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by **TWO**, the male and his female.



## Thursday — Genesis 8:8-9

Also he sent forth a **DOVE** from him, to see if the **WATERS** were abated from off the face of the ground; But the **DOVE** found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the **ARK**, for the **WATERS** were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the **ARK**.





# PRACTICAL CHALLENGE





### Noah Found Grace — Genesis 6:8-13

*<sup>8</sup> But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.*

*<sup>9</sup> These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.*

*<sup>10</sup> And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.*

*<sup>11</sup> The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.*

*<sup>12</sup> And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.*







*19 And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every sort shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep them alive with thee; they shall be male and female.*



Obeying God is very important.







*18 And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.*

*19 And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that were under the whole heaven, were covered.*

*20 Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.*

*21 And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man:*

*22 All in whose nostrils was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died.*

This shows us that God didn't have the waters barely cover the mountains – but fully covered them with lots of water. (Hint: you might need to do this outside!)

### ACTIVITY

The ark is an amazing design by God and given from Him to Noah. Did you know that the dimensions of the ark have been found to be perfect for a ship's balance and safety? In 1993 a study was done by a scientist called Dr. Seon in South Korea. He compared 12 different proportions of boats to see which was the best. Dr. Seon found that the 4,300 year old God-designed ark was the best! He also discovered that if you changed it so that it was longer or wider by even a little bit, then it would make the boat unsafe and more likely to break. Did you know that they have also proven that Noah's ark was able to handle waves 100 feet high! Our God is an amazing designer, we can see that all around us everyday in creation.

For this activity you will need a buddy! Read **Genesis 6:15** again and using 18 inches for a cubit measure out how long the ark was. You might need to have a parent take you to a playground field to do this because it is so long! (Hint: 300 times 18 divided by 12 = 450 feet!)




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## Challenge #3





TALK ABOUT IT

We can see through the whole Bible, and history, that God has used weather to fulfill His word. The awe-inspiring flood that He brought at the time of Noah is a fantastic example of the authority and control that God has over the weather. The next time there is a scary storm, a very fast wind, or even an earthquake, remember that God is in control and just like He kept Noah safe He will keep us safe as well.

*<sup>10</sup> And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark;*

*<sup>11</sup> And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth was an olive leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.*

*<sup>12</sup> And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.*

*<sup>13</sup> And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.*

*<sup>14</sup> And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.*



### Challenge #5

**Read Hebrews 11:6-7.** During the family Bible readings tonight, talk about how important faith is. An easy way to picture faith is when you look at a nest with bird's eggs in it. You know that there is a baby bird in each of those eggs – even though you can't see them. We have faith that God will keep His promises to us and very soon send Jesus back to earth to set up the Kingdom.

**The Challenge:** Just like all the people mentioned in Hebrews 11, Noah didn't just have faith, he did something with his faith. Noah built the ark because of his faith in God and saved his family. **2 Peter 2:5** also tells us that he preached to everyone around him about the coming judgement of God on the wicked world by a flood. The ark would have been the most spectacular prop for a public lecture ever! Talk about some ways that you can preach to those around you about the coming judgement of God on the wicked world that we live in and the hope of the coming Kingdom of God. Write down or draw 2 of these ways. This would be a good chat to have at Bible readings or family dinner time.
