god for help. God told  Daniel the  dream and what it meant so Daniel went to

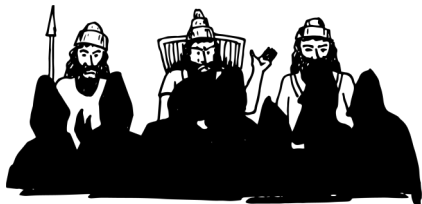

**some ways we can remember God is with us by memorising Bible verses and having friends that remind us that He is there to help us.**

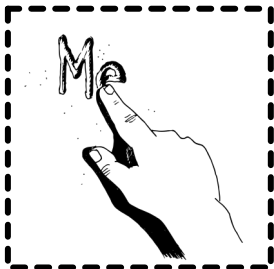
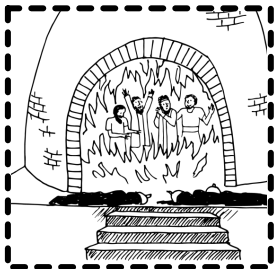
