

Dear Parents and Squirts,

We are excited that you are planning to join us for Camp this year!

This is an optional workbook to give the squirts the opportunity to feel a part of the lessons that their “big brothers” or “big sisters” are working on for camp. If your child turns 3, 4, or 5 by the end of 2023, then they would complete this “younger” squirt workbook.  Jacob and changed his wages seven times, but God was with  Jacob and helped


him by increasing his flocks until his cattle was stronger than his uncle

 Laban's!  Jacob stayed there until God told him it was time to go home.




