We have also included the memory verses for the week that the young people will be looking at just in case you wish to learn them as well.

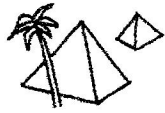

Follow the directions to color the picture of Baby Moses, Miriam and the kind princess.



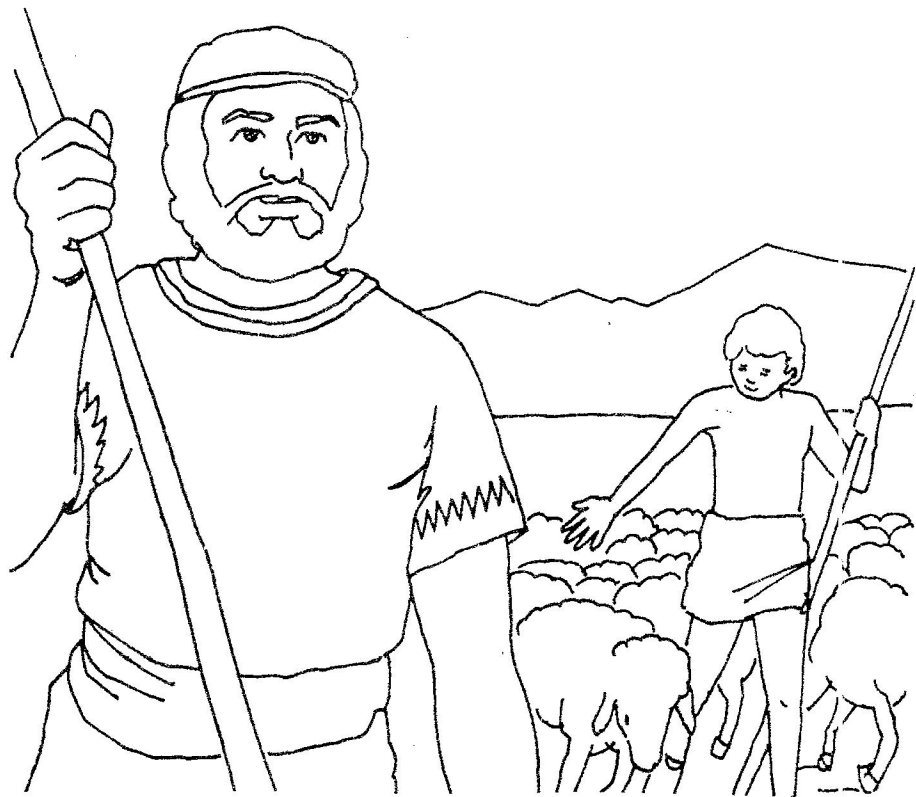
For the Teacher: Discuss with the children how God took care of Baby Moses. Help them to understand that God is taking care of them just as He took care of Baby Moses.

The Ten Plagues of Egypt



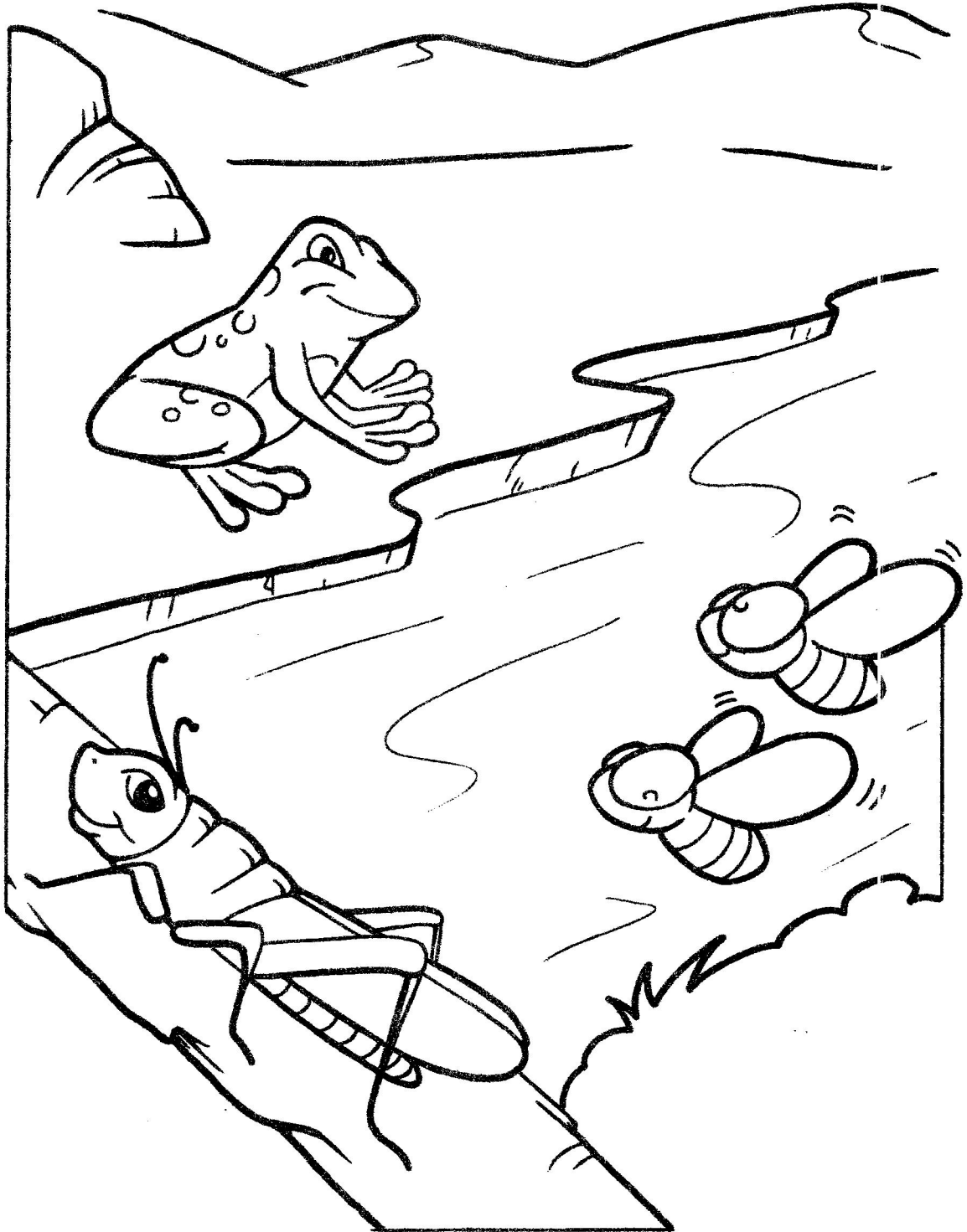
Color each pair of matching frogs the same color.

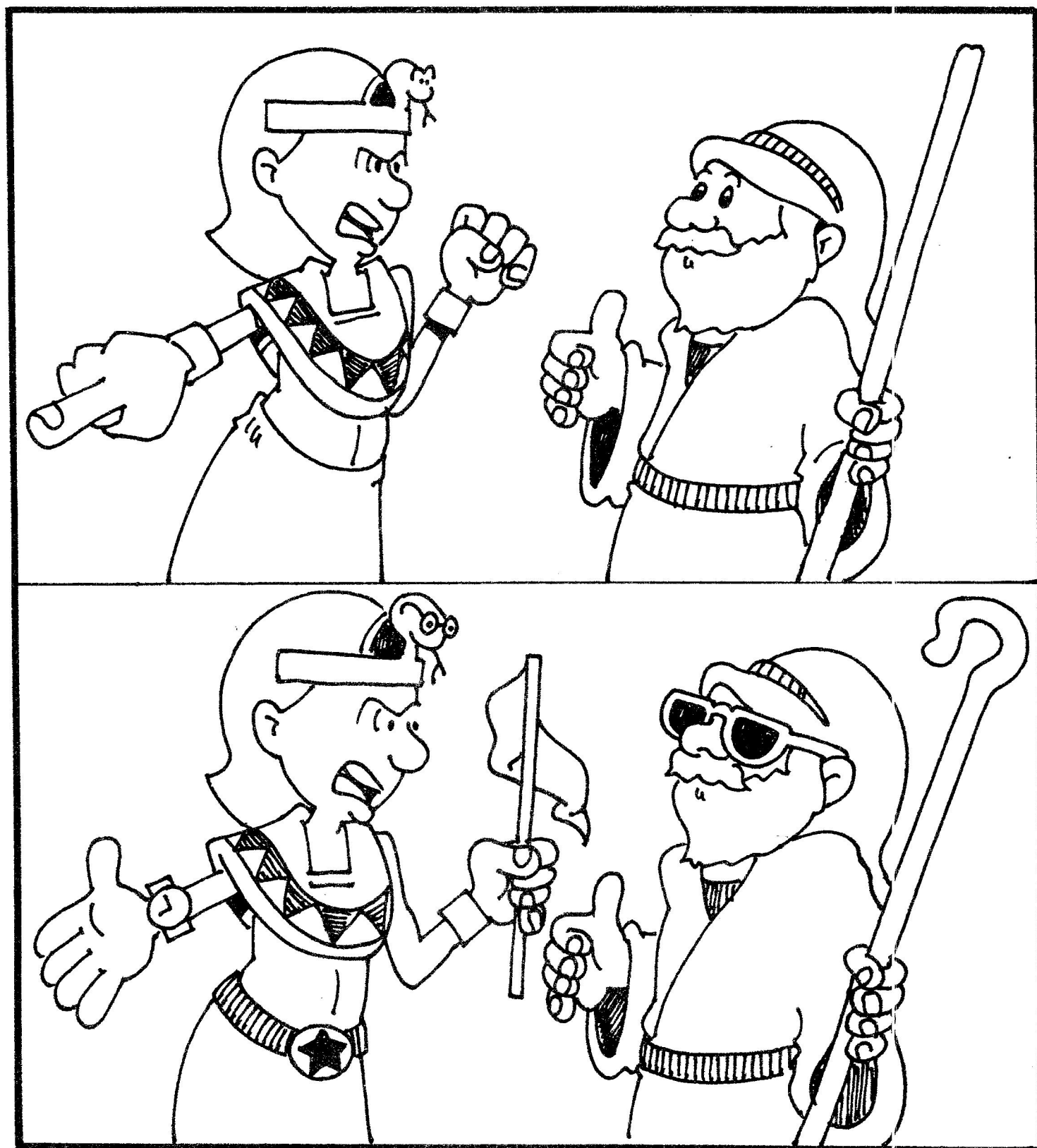

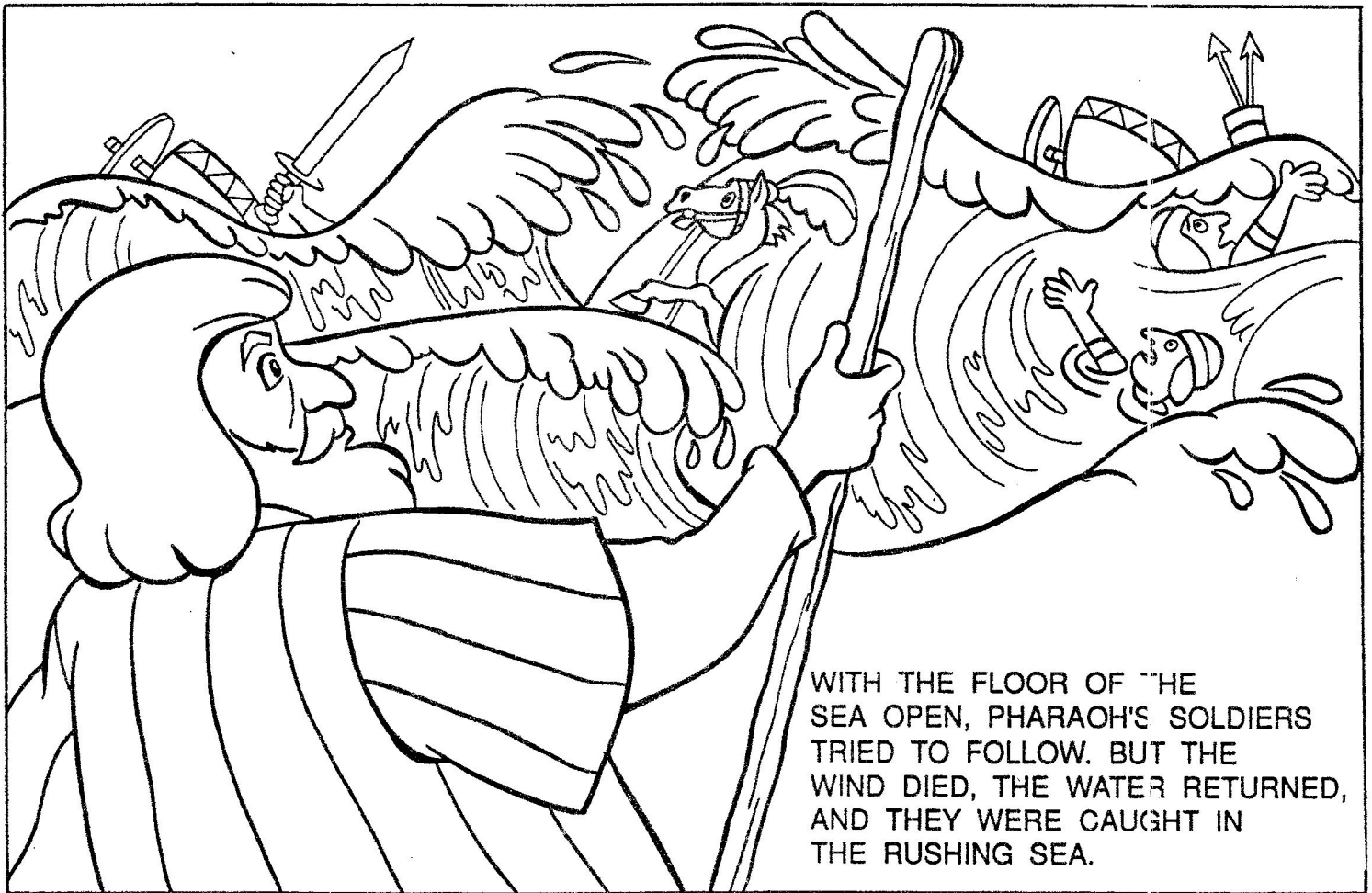

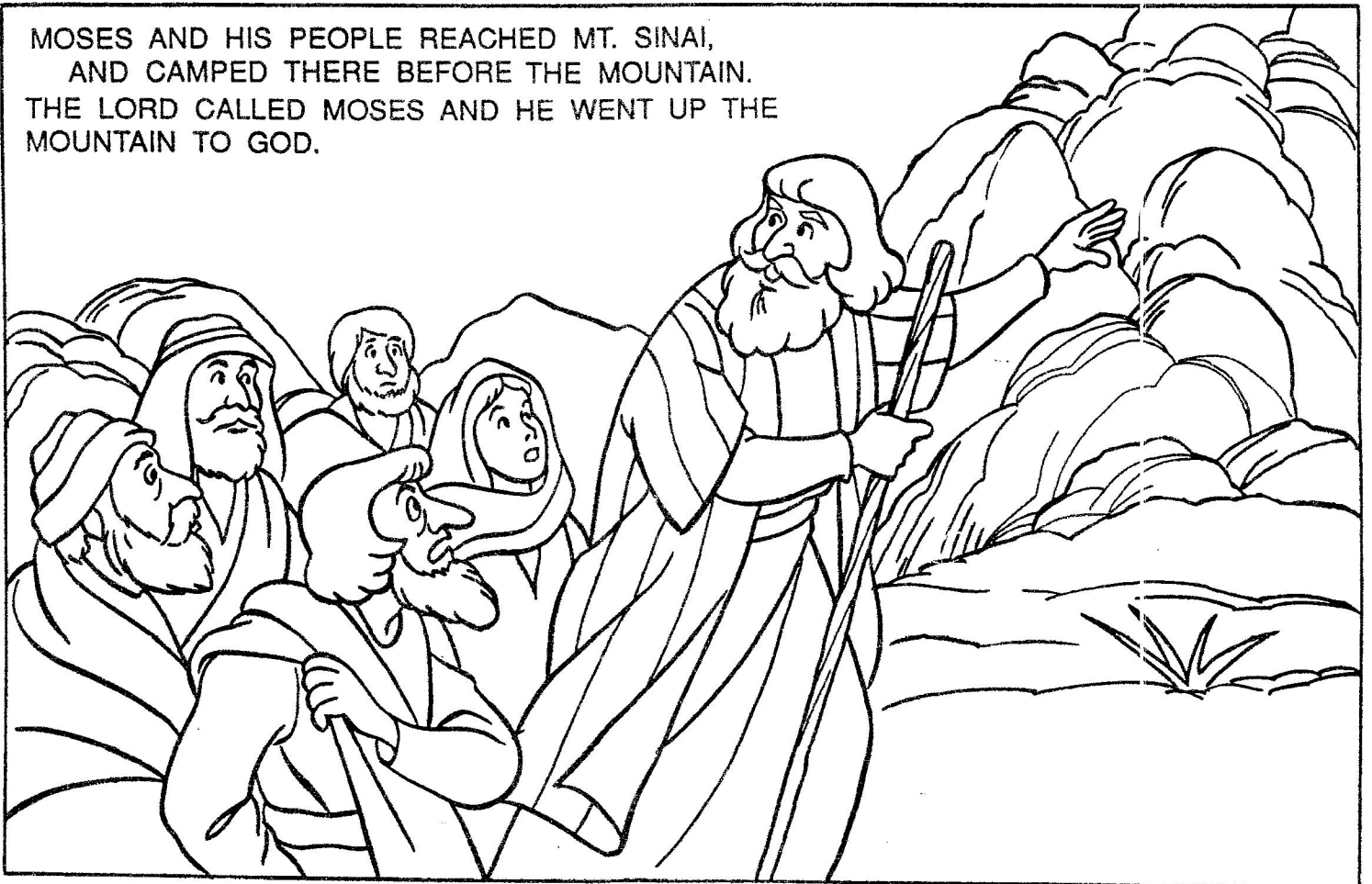
