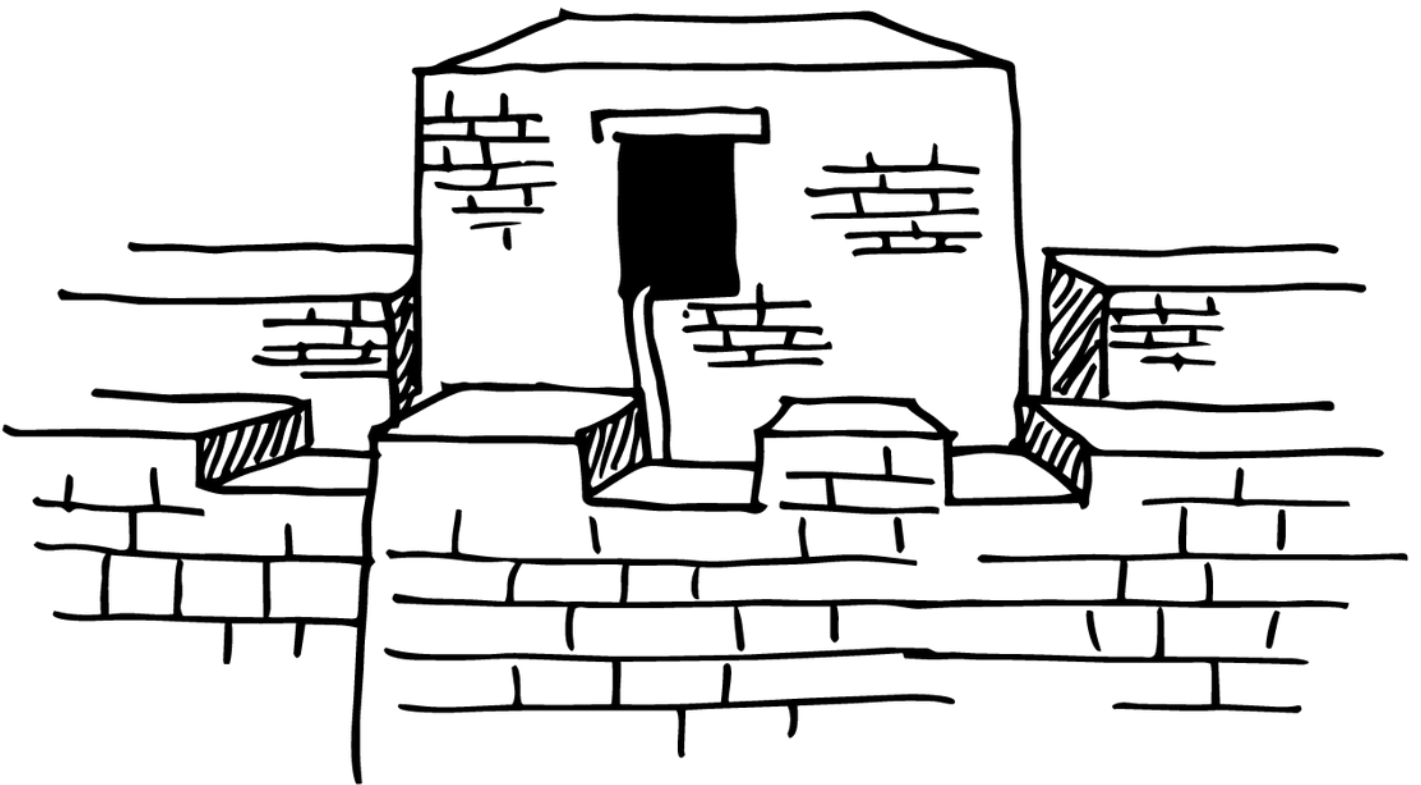

Dear Parents and Squirts,

We are excited that you are planning to join us at Camp this year, God willing!

This is an optional workbook to give the squirts the opportunity to feel a part of the lessons that their “big brothers” or “big sisters” are working on for camp. If your child turns 3, 4, 5, or 6 by the end of 2026, then they would complete this “younger” squirt workbook. (If they are 7 or 8 by the end of 2026, then they would complete this “older” squirt workbook.) Alternatively, kids are welcome to complete the squirt workbook that seems to be age appropriate for them.

The stories in the workbook are as follows:

Joshua 1-2: Be Strong and of Good Courage: Joshua and Rahab

Joshua 3-4: Israel Crosses the Jordan

Joshua 6: Destruction of Jericho

Joshua 7-8: The Battle against Ai

Joshua 23-24: The Death of Joshua

You will notice that the stories do not follow the older children’s lesson plans exactly. Instead we have tried to include highlights that would be comprehensible and enjoyable for this level of squirts. We have also used the New King James Version for all of the included passages.

On the page following, we have included the memory verses for the week. The squirts are not required to memorize them, but they may enjoy learning them to participate with the older siblings during the week.

Do what you can and enjoy the workbook. We hope you are excited for Youth Camp and look forward to seeing you.

MONDAY – JOS. 3:10

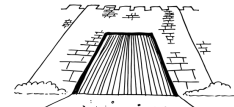


SECTION ONE: JOSHUA AND RAHAB

After Moses, God’s servant, died it was time for someone else to take over his



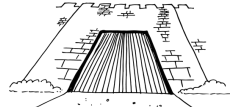
job of leading God’s people. God chose a man named Joshua to be the new

there was a woman named Rahab. The two spies met Rahab and decided to



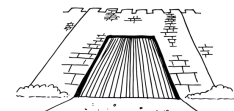
stay with her. The king of Jericho was not very happy that there were spies in



his city. He sent soldiers to try and find Joshua’s men! Rahab hid them on her



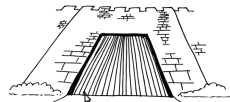
roof under flax! Rahab made the spies promise that they would remember her

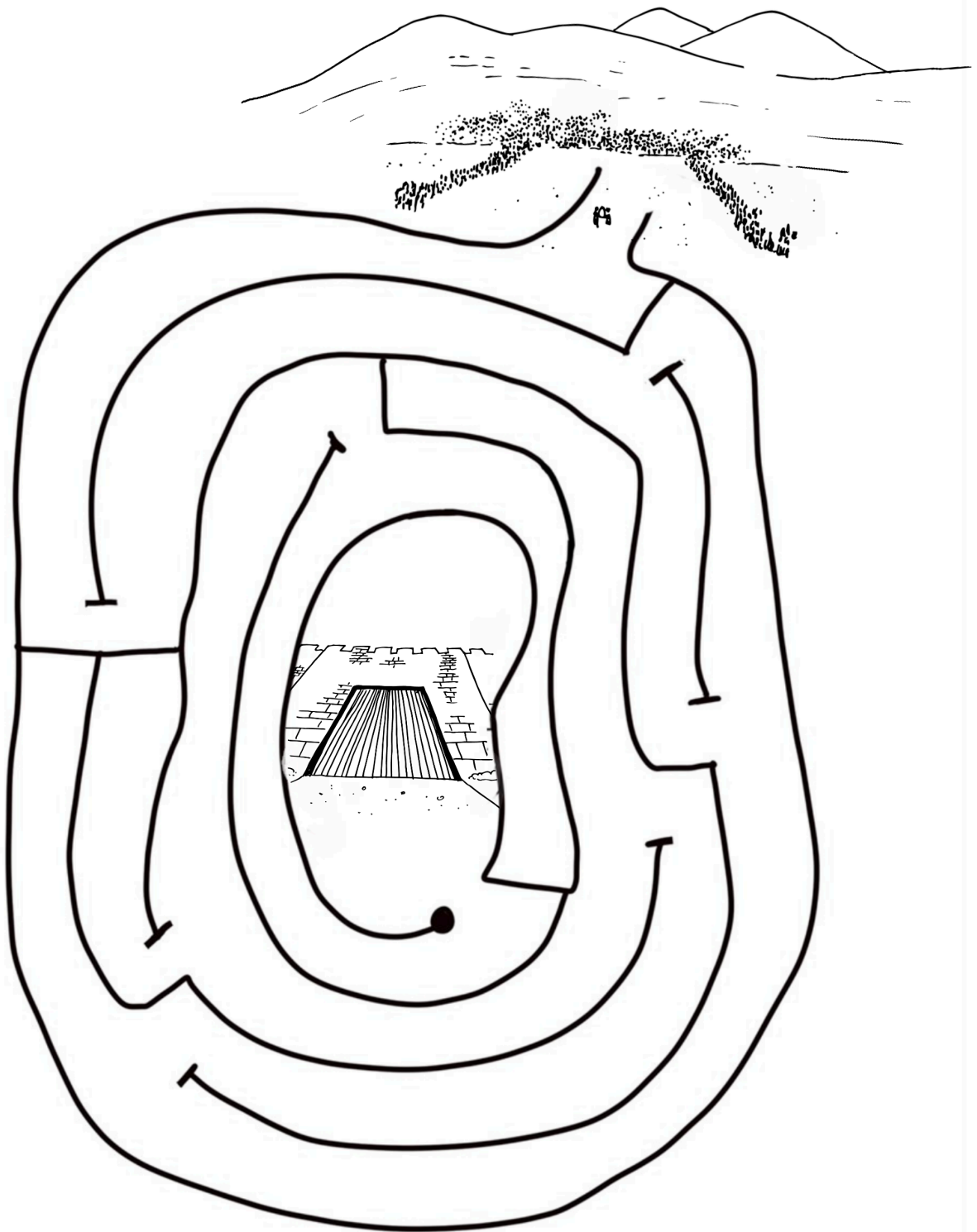

Now Jericho had shut the gates and God told Joshua how they would take

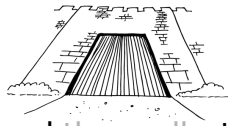

Jericho. God told Joshua to walk around the walls once every day for six days.

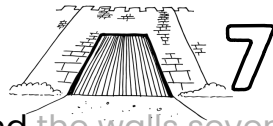

they walked around the walls, they couldn't even say a word! On the seventh day,

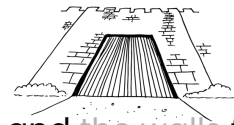
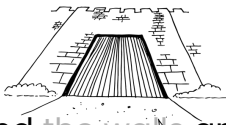

given you the city!" So the seven priests blew their trumpets as they marched



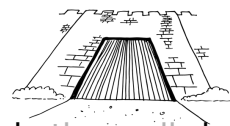
around the walls and all the people shouted with a great shout and the walls fell

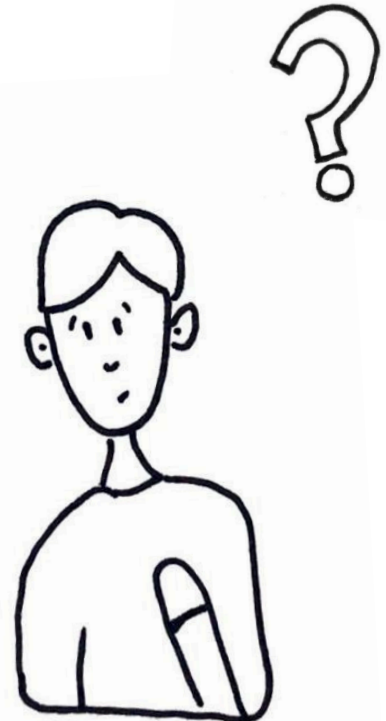


DESTRUCTION OF JERICHO - A LESSON FOR ME

The next city for Joshua to conquer was called Ai. Joshua sent about 3000 men,



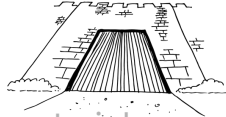
but this time they had to run away from the people of Ai! The children of Israel

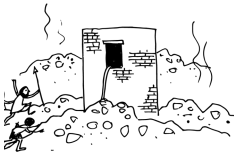
